

UPPER MEDWAY INTERNAL DRAINAGE BOARD  
LAND DRAINAGE ACT 1991 (The Act)  
BOOK OF DRAINAGE RATES AND SPECIAL LEVIES  
FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 31<sup>st</sup> MARCH, 2020

On the 22 January 2019 the Board resolved as follows: -

1. That the proportion of its expenditure to be raised by drainage rates in respect of agricultural land and agricultural buildings and by special levies on local charging authorities is 8.1901% and 91.8099% respectively.
2. That the proportion between the local charging authorities of the amount to be raised by special levies is as set out against the special levy for each local charging authority.
3. To make the drainage rate and special levies set out below and that the seal of the Board be affixed to the drainage rate and special levies.
